**NPGA Show; NPGA rules govern and take precedence over all others.** For NPGA classes, each animal's original registration certificate must be presented at check-in. Ownership transfers not yet recorded by the NPGA Central Office require a transfer form dated not more than 90 days before the show to be presented with original NPGA certificate at check-in. **Photocopies of certificates and transfers are not acceptable.**

Bucks & Does with the Judge's herd name cannot be shown under that judge.

**ENTRY FEES:** All classes with the exception prospective buck will be as follows:

RMPGC club members \$6 per head per class, non-members \$7 per head per class

PROSPECTIVE BUCK/UNALTERED WETHERS \$4 per head per class

A late fee of \$5.00 per head per class will apply to entries postmarked after June 30<sup>th</sup> & substitutions at check-in are subject to an additional \$5 / head / class unless prior arrangements have been made.

No refunds will be made without a showing of severe hardship (written notice required and must be received before the show date). \***Unregistered Doe** (2 each)  
\***Prospective Buck/unaltered wethers** (2 each)

### \*\*\*YOUTH SHOW\*\*\*

**NPGA Sanctioned Youth Show Friday night for ages 19 and under. Classes will include (1 each) Doe, Wether, Unregistered Doe and Showmanship.**

**Entry fees for the youth show are \$6.00 per class per entry.**

### \*\*\*PROSPECTIVE BUCKS/ UNALTERED WETHERS\*\*\*

**Bucks 0-6 months that are not registered or wethered yet.**

**This is not an NPGA sanctioned class but is an evaluation class to help the owner determine whether or not the animal should be wethered or if the owner wants to show and animal is too young to be wethered.**

**Entry fees for this class are \$4 per class per entry.**

### \*\*\*UNREGISTERED DOES\*\*\*

**This is not an NPGA sanctioned class but a class for those who have unregistered pygmies & crossbreeds to give them the opportunity to participate and show. Please DO NOT enter animals that are eligible for registration in this class**

**Entry fees for this class are \$6 per class per entry for club members & \$7.00 for non club members**

**HEALTH:** All animals must be parasite free and in good health. Animals will be inspected before pens are assigned. At the sole discretion of the show chairs, **ANY ANIMAL** showing signs of parasite infestation or disease will be quarantined away from other stock or refused access to the premises - in either event, the animal will not be shown and there will be no entry refunds.

**PENS: \$6.00 each.** The facility includes pens (5'x5'). Straw is included in the pen price but exhibitors may furnish their own bedding if preferred. Plastic fencing or other appropriate small opening fencing (to line the pens) is suggested for young kids.

**\*\*\*REMOVAL OF BEDDING FROM ALL PENS FOLLOWING THE SHOW IS REQUIRED\*\*\***

**WHERE TO STAY :** There are several nice Hotels/Motels in the area. However,

**The Best Western Plus** at 1377 Blue Lakes Blvd N will give us a rate of \$102. **RV/Camping:** RV Parking & camping are available just adjacent to show grounds for \$21.20 per night (includes tax). The camping area is extremely nice and very close to the show ring. Restrooms with showers are also on site. The club will be responsible for collection of the camping fees. Please include payment on the entry form. A paid slip will be issued upon check in.

**FEED/FOOD:** Goats: There are a few feed / farm supply stores in the Twin Falls area.

People: Jeff Breeding will be grilling hamburgers, hotdogs & various other items throughout the day and some breakfast items in the mornings. Other goodies and snack items will also be available for purchase including drinks and water. We will again be offering everyone a tab for food and raffle items since this has worked very well in the past. Please remember all tabs must be paid in full by Saturday late afternoon/early evening.

**OTHER RULES:**

1. All tattooing must be done before the show starts.
2. Any complaints - about procedure, exhibitors, judges, facilities, or otherwise - are to be brought immediately to the attention of the show secretary.
3. Please wear (prominently displayed on the front of your shirt) your correct exhibitor number for each class in which you participate.
4. The **Release** on the entry form must be signed in order to participate.

**CHECK -IN:** 3:00 – 9:00PM Friday 7/06/18. Late arrivals (after 9:00 PM.) will not be able to check in until Saturday morning before the start of the show unless prior arrangements have been made.
